



Sixth Grade Assessment Required in 2010

Beginning with the 2002-2003 school year, schools in Michigan are required to assess and report the immunization status of all sixth grade students.

In the fall of 2010 all sixth graders must have documentation showing that they have had the following immunizations:

- Two doses of MMR
- Three doses of hepatitis B
- Complete series of DTaP/Td (Please consult your physician for current guidelines)
- Three doses of polio
- Two doses of varicella (or history of chickenpox)

This requirement will help assure that school-aged children are up-to-date and protected against vaccine-preventable diseases.
