Summer at Sacred Heart Now Enrolling for Day Camps, Sports Camps and Tutoring

Bloomfield Hills - The Academy of the Sacred Heart's "Summer at Sacred Heart" program is currently enrolling students for day camps, sports camps, tutoring and extended care to take place between June 8 and August 14.

- Day camps, offered primarily for students entering preschool through Grade 6, are presented in a series of themed weeks, including new special interest camps where students will participate in drama and theater, a rock band and an American Girl doll group. A weeklong day camp (July 13-17), "CSI: Bloomfield Hills," is also offered for students in Grades 7-12.
- Sports camps will challenge athletes in Grades 3-9, as they hone skills in basketball (girls and boys), soccer (boys), volleyball (girls), lacrosse (boys and girls) and field hockey (girls). In addition, the school's athletic trainer will present a program on strength, conditioning and injury prevention for students in Grades 5-12.
- Academic tutoring and private music instruction are available from Sacred Heart faculty and area professionals. Sessions in math, language arts, science, piano, voice, guitar and percussion will be tailored to the needs of the individual learner.

Activities take place at the Academy's campus, which is located at 1250 Kensington Road in Bloomfield Hills. The facilities include a state-of-the-art Field House, formal gardens, marked trails, ponds and a marsh.
